

Falls in older adults are the leading cause of injury hospitalizations and fatalities in the United States; primary risk factors are muscle weakness, impaired mobility, and balance deficits.

Public health guidelines include physical activity as a key component for healthy aging (Office of Disease Prevention and Health Promotion, 2016; U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, 2008). The CDC Healthy Aging Research Network recommends that physical activity interventions increase health-related fitness, self-efficacy, and sustainability through the use of community resources (Prohaska et al., 2006). Community settings that encourage physical activity and provide access to safe activity experiences will enhance the likelihood of increased activity among older adults (Watson et al., 2016).

Stay Active and Independent for Life (SAIL) is an evidence-based fall prevention program centered around a strength, balance and fitness program for adults 65 and older that we offer. The classes are offered at the Holdingford City Center on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 to 10:30. We also offer a general exercise class at the Rice Lion's Building on Tuesdays from 12:30 to 1:30.

In a research study by the CDC and the Washington State Department of Health of 331 participants, test results showed significant improvements in strength, balance, and mobility in those who attended classes twice a week or more for more than 2 months. Survey results found that 93% of respondents reported improved performance of daily activities; and 92% reported improved strength, balance, fitness, or flexibility.

CAREGIVING

....is not an easy job and often we find ourselves unprepared for the task at hand. Helping Hands Outreach wants to help. One of the ways we can help is with educational materials to assure you that you are not alone and that others, who have gone ahead, have written materials for you to read as you navigate these new waters.

Helping Hands Outreach has a **library** with various books for caregivers on what to expect and how to manage some of the challenges. We also offer books for the little ones in your life on helping them in storybook form to understand better what is happening with Grandpa or Grandma.

Some of the titles we have include: <u>The Caregiver Notebook</u>, <u>The Caregiver Help Book</u>, <u>The 36-Hour Day</u>, <u>Daily Comforts of Caregiving</u>, <u>Mom, Dad...Can We Talk?</u>, <u>Caring For Your Parents</u>, <u>Life With Pop</u>, <u>A Survival Guide for Family Caregivers</u>, <u>Chicken Soup for the Caregiver's Soul</u>, <u>When Caring Takes Courage</u>, <u>The Unexpected Caregiver</u>, <u>Love</u>, <u>Honor & Value</u>, + many more.

We have DVD's: The Educated Caregiver vol.1 Coping Skills, vol.2 Hands-On, and vol. 3 Essential.

We also have several books for young ones that need help understanding what they are seeing in their loved ones. They include: Why Did Grandma Put Her Underwear In The Refrigerator?, forget me not, Making and Keeping Memories, and The Sunshine on My Face.

All these books are free to be borrowed, read at your leisure and returned in the future at whatever time feels right. If you would like a book and we do not have it in our library, please ask the staff as it may be one that we can get.

We also can help you acquire resources from The Great River Regional Library. We can help you order the books, pick them up and deliver them to your home. All part of the service we provide to help support you and your family as you travel the caregiving journey together.
